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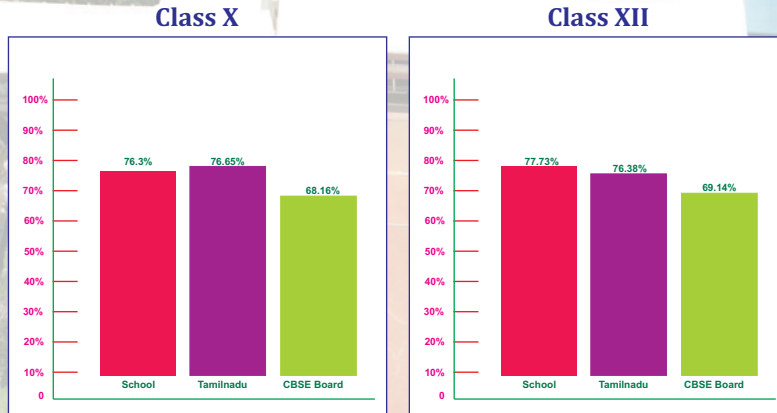

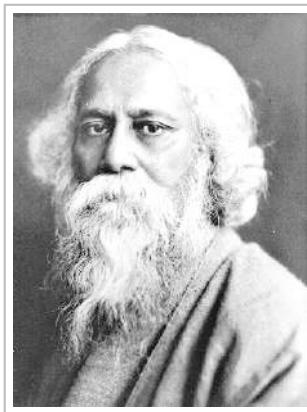

### **Aims & Objectives**

Little Kingdom Senior Secondary School is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi. The founder of the school Mrs. D.Hema started this School in the year 1999 to impart quality education to the students of this knit city.

Tirupur being a miniature India, the school has children from diverse languages and regions. The aim of this school is to give a uniform pattern of education and also to inculcate in its students a feeling of patriotism, brotherhood and national integration.

### **Admission Rules**

The following priorities will be adhered in granting admissions.

- (a) Children of transferable Central Government employees.
- (b) Children of transferable State Government employees.
- (c) Children of nontransferable central & state Government employees.
- (d) Children of transferable bodies / PSUs etc.
- (e) Children from any other category.

### Method of Admission

Parents desirous of admitting their children should collect the application form from the school office, from the 2nd week of December. Admission will however be granted as per priorities given in the admission rule. In case there is a large number of children left out, then the following criteria will be adopted in giving priority for admission.

1. Siblings in Little Kingdom
2. The Child residing near to Little Kingdom School
3. Single girl child.

Skill tests will be conducted for all children who wish to join the school. The subjects for admission test for various class is as follows :

1. Foundation Level ( Playgroup, L.K.G - II)  
Playgroup and L.K.G ----> Interview  
I and II ----> English, Mathematics, Tamil
2. Primary Level (III to V)  
English, Mathematics, EVS, Tamil, Hindi
3. Middle Level ( VI to VIII)  
English, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, Tamil, Hindi
4. Senior Level ( IX to XII)  
IX, X -----> English, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, Tamil, Hindi  
XI, XII ----> Xth Board exam marks.
5. Filled in forms should be submitted with all the required documents within a week's time. Admission will be confirmed only after a personal interaction and on the availability of seats in the particular grade.

### Fee Rules

The fee shall be paid before the 10<sup>th</sup> of every Term. The fee payment is divided into 2 terms March, September. The fee shall be collected before the 10<sup>th</sup> of April and 10<sup>th</sup> of October. A fine of Rs.100/- will be collected if the amount is not remitted on the prescribed date. Children who are found to default the fee payment will be struck off from the admission register. No fees will be refunded on any account and Parents shall not meet the Principal/Management in this regard.

### Withdrawals

Parents who wish to withdraw their child from the school must inform the school administration at least three months in advance before submitting a formal request for the Transfer Certificate (TC). This advance notice helps ensure a smooth transition and completion of necessary formalities. Failure to provide the required notice may result in additional fees as per school regulations. For further assistance, parents are requested to contact the school office.

## Curriculum of studies

Education in Little Kingdom School spans over a period of twelve +3 years from class Play school to XII. The examination and courses of study followed upto class XII are those prepared by the National Council of Education Research and Training and prescribed by the Central Board of Secondary Education. Class X & Class XII students are prepared for the Secondary School Exam & Senior Secondary Examination conducted by the Board, Due emphasis is laid on the curriculum on national identity and value education.

## Tests, Examination & Promotions

Unit tests will be conducted regularly in each subject as many times as necessary with a minimum of 03 tests. For classes I to VIII the promotion will be based on their overall performance in all the tests held throughout the year. There will be 2 main exams in September and March

VI - IX , XI ANNUAL EXAMINATION - The student must obtain 35% marks in each of the academic subjects maintaining the aggregate of 35% in all the subjects(academic).

**X, XII - CBSE, BOARD EXAMINATION**

## Attendance

Students having less than 75% attendance in an academic session will not be allowed to sit in the session ending examination. The Principal is authorized to condense shortage in attendance upto 15% in special circumstances like illness etc. A pupil who has not put in atleast 60% attendance shall be detained in the same class.

Attendance on the first day after vacation is compulsory



## TO THE STUDENTS

### Punctuality and Regularity

1. Be punctual to the school.
2. Reach the school atleast 10 minutes before the commencement of the Assembly.
3. Submit your classwork, homework, note books, assignments and projects to your teachers regularly.
4. Don't absent yourself for any test.
5. Leave is to be taken only when it is absolutely essential. Leave letter should be submitted atleast 3 days before in case of preplanned leave. For emergencies like sickness, leave letter to be submitted on arrival with proper reasons.
6. Children absenting for more than 10 days without prior permission will be struck off the rolls.
7. The Pupil who puts in 100% attendance will be given prize.

### Conduct

1. Your uniform, shoes and other clothing items should be neat and tidy.
2. Be regular and listen in the assembly.
3. Help to keep your classroom neat and clean.
4. Don't loiter outside the classroom during the session.
5. Inculcate the habit of going to the toilet during the times specified.
6. While moving as a class move in a line always.
7. Bring all your prescribed text books and notebooks as per the time table.
8. Take care of your things.
9. Don't make noise when there is no teacher in the class. Inform the library for a substitute if the teacher is absent.
10. Develop the habit of reading Newspapers / Magazines.
11. Be an active participant in your school activity.
12. Follow up to the correctness and suggestions given by the teacher.
13. Students are strictly advised not to chew bubblegums in the school campus.
14. Students shall not bring whitener, pelicans etc. to the school.
15. Boys should strictly come with proper hair cut.
16. Girls are requested not to wear any costly jewellery.



### Laboratory Rules

1. Observe complete silence.
2. Get the experiments allotted in advance.
3. Come prepared with the theory procedure of the experiment.
4. Follow instructions given by the Teacher / Lab in - charge.
5. Be careful in handling the apparatus.
6. Any breakage or loss, report to the Teacher. The student will be held responsible for the breakage.

### Library Rules

1. No personal belongings inside the Library.
2. Books can be borrowed on library cards.
3. Period of return is 14 days after which a fine of Rs.5/- will be levied per extra day.
4. Damage or Mutilation or loss will be charged from the borrower.
5. Students found stealing books will be expelled from the school.

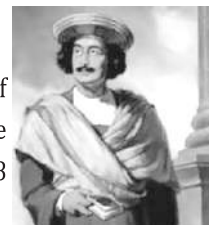
### Shivaji

### Raja Ram Mohan Roy

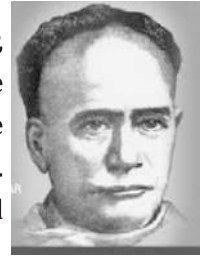

### **Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar**

Vidyasagar was a philosopher, educator, writer, publisher, entrepreneur, reformer and philanthropist. Vidyasagar was one of the first persons in India to realize that modern science was the key to India's future. He translated into Bengali the English biographies of some outstanding scientists like Newton, Copernicus. Vidyasagar vigorously promoted the idea that regardless of their caste, both men and women should receive the best education.



### **House system**
