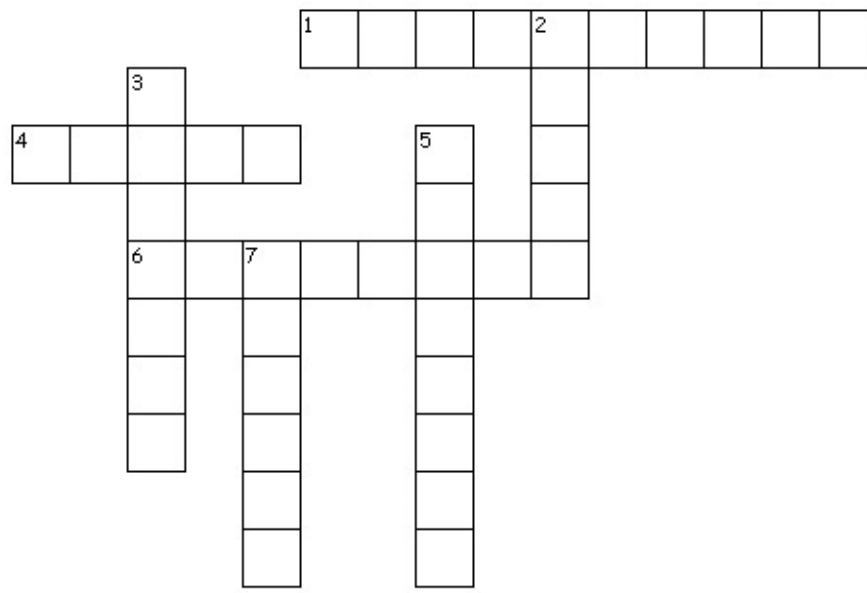

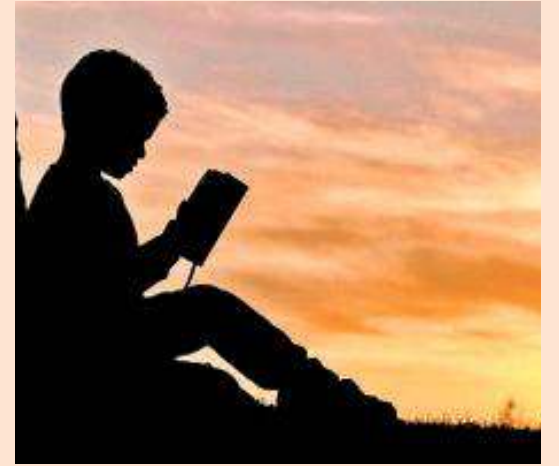
- This gas has the chemical formula O₃

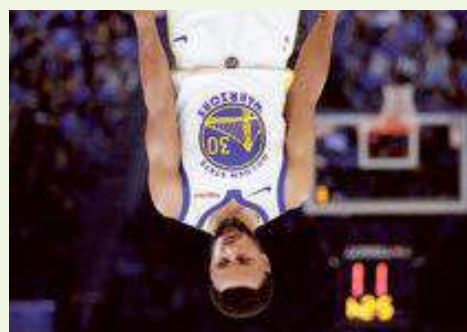
