- (i) To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person (including all or any of the Trustees and committees or administrator or Managing Trustee's or otherwise) for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulation as the Trustees may prescribe and also to appoint or provide for the appointment of separate Trustees to hold any fund or investment subject to the provisions of this Deed in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustees may from time to time think fit.
- (k) To make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/orrunning any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust.
- (I) To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity or charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscription or donation made by them.
- (m) To set apart and/or allocate the whole or a part of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.
- (n) To join, co-operate or amalgamate this trust with other or others having kindred or allied objects, upon such terms and conditions as the trustees may in their discretion think fit, particularly having regard to and in conformity with the objects and nature of this Trust.
- (o) To give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or otherwise, to different charitable institutions, societies, organizations

or Trusts in India which may have been established or which may hereafter be established for the like charitable purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institution, societies, organization or Trustees to start maintain, or carry out such charitable objects.

- (p) To settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon, or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claim, demand, or things, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- (q) To borrow moneys either on the security of any property comprised in the Trust Fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of these presents, and it 'shall be lawful for the Trustees to make such borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
- (r) To apply to the Government, public bodies, urban, local municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions, and other assistance with a view to promoting the objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government Departments, public and other bodies corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to conform to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.
- (s) To take over or amalgamate with any other charitable trust, society, association or institution with similar objects.
- (t) To establish, promote, manage, organize or maintain or to assist in establishing, promoting, managing, organizing, or maintaining any branch of the Trust or any other Trust or its branch with objects similar to those of this Trust and to promote or carry on the affiliation or amalgamation of such other Trust with this Trust.

- (u) To take over, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing institution or institutions having objects either wholly or in part similar to those of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.
- (v) To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the trusts, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate.
- (w) To transfer all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagements of this Trust to any one or more of the trust, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate.
- (x) To transfer agd hand over the Trust to any other Society, Corporation, Institution, Trust or Organization on such terms and conditions as the Trustees shall in their absolute discretion think fit and proper to be held by the Society, Corporation, Institution, Trust or Organization with the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations, appearing and contained in these presents subject to such modification as may be necessary and consequent to such transfer of the Trust Fund. The Trustees for the time being of these presents shall become discharged from the Trust hereof relating to Trust Funds so transferred.
- The Managing Trustee has, in addition to the general powers of the trustees
 as mentioned above, the following powers.
- a. The Managing Trustee shall look after the routine administration of the Trust, its property and affairs, convening meetings of the Trustees, maintaining minutes, accounts, records and other documents of the trust.

- b. The Managing Trustee for the time being shall have the custody of all deeds and documents of title relating to trust property and investments and the books of account and other records relating to the trust and shall be responsible for the same.
- c. The Managing Trustee shall have, subject to the collective supervision, control, direction and superintendence of the trustees, all and every power for the purpose of managing, conducting and administering the affairs of the trust and institutions and establishments owned, run or conducted by the Trust.
- The Managing Trustee has power to make and prescribe additional rules and regulations for the purpose of carrying out any objects of the trust.
- The Managing Trustee can appoint, terminate, suspend or otherwise deal with the employees.
- f. The Managing Trustee shall have power to appeal and set before court, tribunals and public offices.
- g. The Managing Trustee shall have power to open account in the name of the trust in any bank and same shall be operated by the Managing Trustee along with any one of the remaining trustees.
- 10. The Trustees shall be accountable only for such moneys, stocks, shares and funds as shall actually come into their hands and a Trustee shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default, acts, or omission or commission of the other Trustees, nor of any banker or other person with whom the trust properties or any securities may have been deposited or kept.
- The Trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration, but the Trustees
 may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by them in connection
 with the Trust or their duties relating thereto.

- 12. The number opthe Trustees shall not be less than seven and more than ten. If the number of the Trustees shall fall below six, the Trustees shall not, except for the purpose of filling any vacancy, act so long number is below the said minimum.
- 13. The Managing Trustee shall appoint additional Trustees within the number mentioned above for such period or on such terms as to the retirement and re-appointment of the trustees for the time being considered proper. Such appointment shall be made on the advise of majority of the trustees. A person shall cease to be a Trustee either:
- (i) if he without leave of absence does not attend three consecutive meetings of the Trustees or for one calendar year, whichever is longer, or
- (ii) if he is requested to resign by 3/4th or as near thereto as possible of the remaining Trustees.
- Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his intention to do so.
- 15. The Managing Trustee shall, during her life so long as he shall remain a trustee of this deed, always be and have the privileges of the Chairman of any meeting at which she shall be present and it shall not be competent for the trustees by any rules made or resolution passed by them or otherwise to deprive her of her right but he may waive such right when and so often as she may please.
- 16. The Trustees may from time to time frame rules for the conduct and regulations of the meetings of trustees. In the absence of such regulations:
- (a) Four Trustees shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Trustees.
- (b) All matters will be decided mutually by the Trustees.



- (d) A meeting of the trustees may be called by any trustee by giving not less than seven days notice in writing specifying the date, place and time of such meeting and the nature of the business to be transacted at the meeting. Such notice shall be sent by post or hand delivered to every trustee. The accidental omission to give notice to or the non-receipt of notice by any trustee shall not invalidate the proceedings at such meeting. With the consent of the all the trustees, a meeting may be convened by such shorter notice in such manner as the trustees may think fit.
- (e) A minute book shall be maintained in which shall be recorded the proceedings of every meeting of the trustees and it shall be signed by the chairman of the at meeting.
- 17. The Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether array moneys or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoings ought to be paid or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusive provided that nothing contained shall be deemed to authorize the Trustees to spend the income or corpus of the Trust for any purpose not authorized by these presents.
- 18. The trustees shall be fully kept indemnified and harmless by the Trust again st any action or claim, loss suffered or liability arising against them, on accourt of anything done by them in good faith pursuant to the powers and authori ty conferred on them by these presents.

 That the Trustees shall always maintain proper accounts of the Trust, which shall be kept at the office of the trust.
